Staff update:

Congratulations to Múinteoirí *Aisling, Odhrán, Stiofán, Dayna & Éamonn* who have successfully been appointed to fixed term positions for the coming school year.

We welcome Múinteoir *Cian MacAodhagáin* who will be covering a maternity leave position this year.

We welcome back Múinteoir *Kate* from Gaelscoil Nás na Ríogh, who is job sharing with Múinteoir *Eimear* in an inter job share arrangement for the coming year.

We bid farewell to Múinteoir *Bríd* who is no longer with the teaching team of GSNP. We sincerely want to thank Bríd for her wonderful work carried out as an excellent team member and class teacher. We would like to offer our thanks for the extra responsibilities assumed both willingly and voluntarily.

We also welcome back *Niamh Colfer* who will fill one of our SNA positions for the coming year. And a special welcome to *Sylvia Jones* who will fill another SNA position this year

Safe Cycling Classes

Classes will begin on Tuesday **7-9-21** for the pupils of **R5, R6**. Further details have been sent to parents this week. A big thank you to Redempta who has secured a grant from 'An Taisce and the South Dublin County Council. The Parents Association fund the remainder from fundraising last year. The lessons are free of charge for 5th and 6th students as a result. Your child is welcome to bring their own bicycle and helmet into school for use during the cycling classes.

Yoga Classes:

All classes will be facilitated to attend 8 Yoga sessions with Mary Reynolds who will be our Yoga Instructor! The 5th and 6th classes will attend 11/12 sessions as the violin classes plan for 5th and 6th has been amended and no longer include 5th and 6th for the class sessions (see below for further details)

Violin/Cello Classes:

We hope to resume violin and cello classes in the new year once permitted. Classes will be provided for students from senior infants to 4th class this year. Any 5th or 6th class student who wishes to continue playing music will be facilitated through the ceolfhoireann scoile (school orchestra) who will practice at lunch time once a week.

Cumann na mBunscoil (GAA):

At this point, there will be no Cumann na mBunscoil competition this side of Christmas anyway. However, we do intend in trying to arrange training for the **Girls and Boys Football** Training. We will have to see what is possible logistically before we name classes. We will prioritise the older classes as their time in the school is more limited. Further details to follow.

Athletics:

We also hope to resume with Athletics training in the near future. The schedule will depend on how we can manage this logistically factoring in demand in numbers, Covid restrictions, and availability of all-weather pitch

Swimming Lessons:

We have a revised swimming schedule for the coming year. Due to Covid measures in Clondalkin Leisure Centre, our initial plan is to facilitate an individual class to attend swimming lessons from Wednesday **08/09/21** for 6 weeks during school hours. The same will apply for the next class group. We have 2 classes per week scheduled in thereafter. We have swimming classes for 2nd - 6th only this year. Please see the additional attachment of swimming dates for all of the other classes.

Library sessions in school:

We will be re-opening the library in late September. Each class will attend the school library on a fortnightly basis. There will be a reduced limit on the amount of books the students can take out on loan

Internet Safety:

ZEEKO will be providing Internet Safety workshops for 4th, 5th and 6th classes during the 1st term. The workshops will take place over 2 days on Monday the 11th and Tuesday the 12th of October. There will also be a Parents' Talk on zoom on Tuesday evening (12/10/21) from 19:00 - 20:00.

General Information - Please take note of the following points:

Enrolment for 2022:

If you have a child due to start in September 2022, the enrolment policy will be available on the school website during the month of October 2021. Keep an eye out for the Annual Notice which will be on the school website soon. The timeframe for submission of applications will take place during the month of November. www.gsnp.ie

Gaeilge:

It is so important to understand that while in the school grounds of GSNP we are all effectively operating in a Gaeltacht. This means that the 'Gaeilge' is the spoken language in the school at all times. It is imperative to send the appropriate positive message out to the children and lead by example. That said, the main objective has to be that a parent/guardian can communicate clearly with the school. The main point is, no matter how little Irish you have, I would be very grateful if you try to use it!

Communicating Covid related concerns:

Safety re: parking and pedestrians:

To ensure the safety of all our children please take care when parking your car. No cars may be parked in the bus section or beyond the cones. We appeal to all to comply with the road markings. Please do not drive through the school gates at any time. Please note that part of Castle Road is now a double yellow line area. Please do not block our neighbours' driveways. At the bottom of Castle Road, the road continues towards the Esker Educate Together 'set-down' area. You are welcome to park in the marked parking spaces. There is a limited number of spaces. No cars should be parked on the road near the green gates where the road narrows. This causes a traffic obstruction and blocks cars from driving up or down on the roadway part of the set-down area. I advise that parents and children be very careful crossing the road as the traffic is not compelled to stop on the roadway. Finally, I urge you to refrain from making a u-turn at the bend directly before the set-down entrance. A manoeuvre of this nature is extremely dangerous.

Attendance & Punctuality:

It is very important to make every effort to ensure you child presents for school on time (before 09:00). Unavoidable/exceptional circumstances apart; it is crucial to develop a good habit and routine.

If your child is absent you should notify the class teacher via Aladdin explaining reason for absence.

Children should not be collected before the usual finishing times except for urgent reasons. A note must be sent to the class teacher in advance and the child must be collected by their parent/guardian. Children leaving the school early must be signed out at reception by their parent.

Children entering/leaving the school premises in the morning and going home time:

We will continue with the same plan used throughout the last school year. The objective is to minimise contact between class groups. The children will be permitted to enter through the designated gates relevant to the class year from 08:45 onwards. Classes will enter through one of three pedestrian gates. Details highlighting to you the route your child should take coming in to the school have been sent to you via email and are also available to view on our school instagram page.

NB: There will be members of staff on hand to guide and encourage your child to the correct destination (classroom) if/when the need arises.

There will be staggered times at 'going home' time, 1:40 (N2), 2:30 (R1 & R2), 2:35 (R5) & 2:40pm (R3, R4 & R6). The junior infants will be going home at the earlier time of 12:00 on 26th & 27th of August and for the subsequent fortnight

NB: Siblings may enter the school through the same entry point from 08:45 onwards

If your child comes on a bike or scooter to school, please make sure he/she dismounts before coming through the gates. Roller skates must be removed before entering the school gates also. **(No**

skateboards are allowed). Children travelling to school by these means to school should be encouraged to wear helmets and protective gear where necessary. We also encourage that you lock your bicycle/scooter while on the school premises.

Pedestrian School Gate:

In the interests of safety, the pedestrian school gate is to be kept closed at all times during school hours. I appeal to all to close the gate after you, whether you are visiting or leaving the premises.

General Information:

Communication with Teachers:

Please adhere to the following protocols if/when communicating with your child's teacher:

Telephone Call: Please call the school office if you deem the matter to be urgent. Leave a message with the school secretary who will pass on to the class teacher/ SET teacher. The teacher will return your call when available.

Aladdin: All absenteeism and appointments can be communicated to the school/class teacher through Aladdin. The school will use Aladdin for general communication to the school community (via text, noticeboard our email)

SeeSaw: General communication between class teacher and parent will continue through SeeSaw.

Secretary's office (School Office) closing time:

The school office will be closed from **1:05 - 1:35pm Monday-Friday**. The office will re-open @ 1:35pm. There will be no personnel available to answer the office during the lunch time period. Please refrain from calling the office at this time except in cases that are a matter of urgency.

Policies:

We have a Healthy Eating Policy, Code of Behaviour and Anti-Bullying Policy in the school that are available for review on http://gsnp.ie/Polasaithe_Scoile.html. The Code of Behaviour will be reviewed this year.

Mobile Phones in GSNP:

The students/children are not allowed to use a mobile phone during the school day in GSNP or while on the school premises. Children are not allowed to have a phone on their person while on the school premises. If a parent deems it absolutely necessary that their child has a phone on their person, the parent is required to write a letter to the principal explaining why. In an exceptional circumstance where a child does have a phone in school, the phone must be turned off at all times and remain in the child's schoolbag. Standardised Testing:

Please note that the **standardised testing for Irish, English and Maths (R3 & R5 only)** will take place from the week commencing **04-10-21 to the week ending on 22-10-21**. **Standardised tests for Irish only will be administered to R1** during this period. The standardised test results will be communicated in person at the parent/teacher meetings. It is compulsory for 2nd, 4th and 6th

classes to undertake standardised tests again during the month of May 2022. These test results are passed on as mandatory information to the Department of Education and Skills.

Primary Language Curriculum:
